


GETTING HERE

We are funded to provide assistance to women 16 years or older who are living or working in Fremantle, Melville and Cockburn postcode regions.

We provide a range of health promotion, prevention, screening and treatment services for women for a range of sexual, reproductive and mental health issues. Our services are provided by experienced counsellors, doctors and nurses.

FWHC offers a warm and welcoming space and we extend our welcome to migrant and refugee women, Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islanders, lesbian, bisexual, transgender and intersex members of the community.



SERVICES

Clinical

Our Doctors and nurses provide information, advice and treatment on a range of women's health issues, including:

- breast examinations
- pregnancy
- contraception
- antenatal and postnatal care
- sexual health
- mental health issues
- sexually transmitted infections
- unplanned pregnancy management
- menstrual problems
- medical terminations and more.
- cervical screening
- menopause

In addition, our nurses provide:

- well women's health checks
- STI Screening
- cervical cancer screening

General Counselling

Our Counsellors provide a safe, confidential, and non-judgmental place to talk about issues and problems you are facing. We see clients for a range of issues including but not limited to:

- depression
- bereavement and loss
- anxiety
- trauma
- stress
- relationships

Perinatal Counselling

We provide counselling for women experiencing depression, anxiety, and stress while pregnant and/or after the birth of a child until the child is 3 years old.

Short term counselling for up to 10 sessions is available.
